Walt Disney Archives to Hold Major Exhibition at the Bowers Museum!





WALT DISNEY ARCHIVES IS ESTABLISHED

Walt Disney Productions and the Disney family have announced the establishment of the Walt Disney Archives. It will be the goal of the Archives to collect, preserve, catalog and make available for study and use the historical material relating to Walt Disney and the entire Disney organization.

Although the focal point of the collection will be Walt Disney's personal papers and business files, the Archives will be audio-visual oriented, providing facilities for the scholarly study of the studio's motion picture product, character merchandise, art work, publications, awards, photographs and other business records.

David R. Smith, formerly a Reference Librarian at UCLA, has been named to head the archives program. Smith, the recipient of a Master's degree in Library Science from the University of California, Berkeley, also participated in the internship program at the Library of Congress in Washington, D. C. for eighteen months, before joining UCLA in 1965.

In 1967, Smith began the compilation of an extensive Walt Disney bibliography, listing all motion pictures, television programs, books, comics, periodicals and sheet music created by the

Disney Studios, as well as all books and articles about Walt Disney, the Studio and Disneyland. In 1969, Smith conducted the initial surveys for the archives program.

Commenting on the program, Smith has said, "The Walt Disney Archives is an important step, not only for Walt Disney Productions, but for the entertainment industry as well. Too few of the motion picture studios have given thought to the preservation of their history, and because of this fact, a wealth of information has been lost."


