## Bowers Museum Celebrates \$500,000 Lead Gift for Terracotta Warriors Exhibition



Santa Ana, CA – April 2, 2025 – With just eight weeks to go before the highly anticipated opening of *World of the Terracotta Warriors: New Archaeological Discoveries in Shaanxi in the 21st Century*, Bowers Museum is proud to announce a transformational \$500,000 gift from Charles and Ling Zhang.
